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1. Product description

A balanced liquid NPK fertiliser with boron, copper and zinc, formulated for nut crops and general crop nutrition where balanced macro- and micronutrient supply is required.

2. Guaranteed analysis

3. Key agronomic benefits

- Balanced NPK nutrition

4. Recommended use

Soil/fertigation reference rate: 10-40 L/ha according to crop. Foliar reference rate: 150-350 mL/100 L water. Apply according to crop requirement, nutrient analysis, local registration and professional agronomic advice. Do not exceed the label rate.

5. Compatibility and mixing

Before tank mixing, conduct a small-scale jar test. Add to a partially filled tank under agitation. Avoid mixing concentrates directly. Check water quality and local compatibility guidance.

6. Physical and handling characteristics

Packaging	1 L, 5 L, 10 L, 20 L and other approved commercial packs
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7. Storage and shelf-life

Store tightly closed in the original container, in a cool, dry and ventilated area, protected from direct sunlight, frost, heat and incompatible materials. Shelf-life must follow the approved batch and label documentation.
